



HERITAGE CHRISTIAN SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

GENERAL STATEMENT

The uniform is seen as an important part of every day school life. It is also recognised that a smartly dressed school population is well received in the community. All aspects of the uniform are compulsory. If any student continues to disregard the uniform code the Principal and parents will deal with the issue together. An interview/conference will be called to address the issue of support for Heritage Christian School's policies with regard uniform. As an aspect of school identity and belonging, the uniform code is important, and a school-wide expression of support is more than appropriate.

School uniform is compulsory and it is expected that the uniform be worn correctly and tidily.

General Information

- Uniform is available for purchase at Lowes, Settlement City, Port Macquarie
- School uniform is compulsory and it is expected that the uniform be worn correctly and tidily.
- All items except senior ties (available for purchase from school) and school shoes should be purchased from Lowes.
- No extra clothing that is visible can be worn. Eg T-shirts that show above the neckline or hemline of shirts, or designs and logos that are visible through shirts.
- Shirts and blouses must not be visible below the level of jumpers and blazers.

<p>Primary Kindy-Year 6</p> <p>All Seasons</p>	<p>Teal/navy sport polo; navy sports shorts; short navy socks (ankles covered), all black joggers (no coloured graphics or other colours) or black leather lace up school shoes. No coloured laces, no volleys or canvas shoes. Navy track suit pants; navy sloppy-joe with school emblem or zip up jacket with school emblem.</p> <p>Broad-brim school hat with emblem for K-5.</p> <p>Year 6 can wear the secondary school cap if they need a replacement hat during the year.</p> <p>A “no hat, no play” policy applies for the whole year for K-6.</p>
<p>Junior Secondary Year 7 – Year 10</p> <p>All Seasons</p>	<p>Boys – white short-sleeve shirt with logo; navy elastic waist shorts; navy socks; black leather lace up shoes, low-cut below the ankle, but not skater shoes. desert boots, volleys or canvas shoes. Navy zip up jacket with school emblem, navy wool jumper with school emblem or navy fleecy sloppy joe with school emblem in winter.</p>
	<p>Girls – Heritage teal check 2 pleat skirt or navy stretch tailored style slacks; white short-sleeve linen blouse with logo; white socks; black leather lace up shoes. No ballet/slip on style shoes, boots, volleys or canvas shoes. Navy zip up jacket with school emblem, navy wool jumper with school emblem or navy fleecy sloppy joe with school emblem in winter.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">..../PTO</p>

	Both – sports uniform: teal/navy sport polo; navy sport shorts; white socks; good supportive lace up sport joggers, <u>not volleys or canvas shoes and no coloured laces</u> . (navy track suit in winter)
Senior Secondary Years 11 – 12 All Seasons	Boys - white short-sleeve shirt with logo; HCS school tie; belted trousers or shorts; navy socks; black leather lace up shoes (as per Junior Secondary); Navy wool jumper with school emblem, navy zip up jacket with school emblem or school blazer in winter.
	Shorts & Trousers - Boys’ shorts and trousers should not be baggy and should be worn on the waist. Shorts must not extend over the knees.
	Girls – navy skirt, two pleats front plain back or navy stretch tailored style slacks; white short-sleeve linen blouse with logo; HCS school tie; white ankle length socks with no other colour visible. Knee length socks cannot be worn; black leather lace shoes (as per Junior Secondary) <u>No ballet/slip on style shoes, boots, volleys or canvas shoes</u> . Navy wool jumper with school emblem, navy zip up jacket with school emblem or school blazer in winter.
	All Secondary Skirts These must be no shorter than 8cm above knees when kneeling.
Hair	Extremes of fashion are not acceptable, including strong streaks, dyes and multiple braids. K-9 students’ hair should be tied back if it is long and should not cover the eyes. Hair should be tied back by a navy or white ribbon or scrunchie, or navy or white elastics. 10-12 students’ hair must be off the face and hair must be tied back before entering any practical classroom. Eg: Science, D&T and Food Technology.
Make-up	No make-up or coloured nail polish, other than discreet foundation for Years 11-12.
Jewellery	Permissible items include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A watch; • One pair of plain (i.e. no stones or other adornments) ear studs worn in the ear lobes. NOTE: No other piercings are permitted at school or at any school-sponsored function.
Hats	A “no hat, no play” policy applies for the whole year for the K-6. Hats are compulsory for 7-12 students playing sport. We also strongly recommend that all students wear hats during other outdoor time.
